

## Consumer & Residential Mortgage Lender Accreditation Program Checklist (CUIC-DES-CRMLAP)

This 7-course program is accredited by Dalhousie University and was developed in conjunction with the Credit Union National Lenders Committee. The program design includes foundational knowledge for courses followed by courses focused more specifically on consumer loans and residential mortgages. This program is a cornerstone for a career in consumer lending. Course instructional formats vary and include: *CUIC*<sup>®</sup> courses, online and instructor-led courses. On completion of this program, you will become an "Accredited Consumer and Residential Mortgage Lender", an accreditation which is conferred jointly by CUIC Inc. and Dalhousie University.
