

General Business Studies Program Checklist (CUIC-DES-GSP)

This 9-course program provides a balanced overview of key competency areas in general business management. You require (8) general business courses, (1) credit union-specific course and the equivalent of 2 years full-time experience in the co-operative financial services industry. On completing both the academic and experience requirements of this program, you will be awarded the designation *Fellow of Credit Union Institute of Canada (FCUIC)* which is conferred by CUIC Inc. and Dalhousie University.
